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INTRODUCTION

A. General Information.

- 1. Spiritual Warfare is very real, and every biblical counselor must know the reality of the satanic powers which attack and influence people and and must know how to effectively apply biblical counsel to assist people in victory over evil.
- 2. Spiritual Warfare in its biblical understanding is to inform biblical counselors about the reality of the spiritual warfare that effects every person, including believers.
- 3. The Spiritual Warfare Briefing is meant to equip the biblical counselor to effectively navigate the myriads of satanic strong holds in people's lives and offer them lasting freedom and peace for their sake and for the glory of God.

B. Specific Mission Objectives.

- 1. To prepare the biblical counselor in the proper and skillful use of the Bible through a sound understanding of the doctrine regarding Satan and his angels and how they work in this world.
- 2. To effect in the biblical counselor the reality of the evil spiritual world that is at constant work to steal, kill, and to devour every person, including believers.
- 3. To instill in the biblical counselor a greater desire for continued growth in both the spiritual and intellectual realms of which people live in.

- 4. To prepare the biblical counselor for a ministry of the Word of God to effectively counsel those who are under satanic influences, oppression, and even possession, buy identifying and qualifying what is or is not a spiritual attack, and what is the biblical approach to victory.
- 6. To stimulate the biblical counselor and prepare them for further studies in this realm.
- 7. To equip the biblical counselor to confidently and effectually declare that the Word of God indeed does have all of life's answers, including in the realm of the powerful forces of Satan at work in the mind, emotions, and will of mankind.

Definition of Terms

C. Spiritual Warfare.

The reality of the war that wages unseen from the heavens and upon earth as the kingdom of Satan seeks to destroy the works of God, the people of God, and the unsaved alike. It is the reality of Satan's destructive influence upon all societies, people, nations, religions and governments through lies against the truth of God. This evil influence is a relentless assault upon the hearts and minds of mankind.

D. Briefing.

The imparting of information to pertinent parties prior to commencing of an exercise,

duty, or responsibility so as to equip and prepare them for a successful endeavor.

E. Biblical Counseling.

The application of Bible truths to discover the problems that someone is having and the instruction of wisdom to provide them the truth that is able to make them free. It is the use of scriptural wisdom to draw out of the heart of another, the conflict, pain, sorrow, fear, wrong beliefs, unbelief, etc. and instill truth, setting them free.

F. Satan.

The "god of this world," who was formerly known as Lucifer, the anointed Cherub, who infamously rebelled against God, seeking his very throne. He is also called the "Devil," meaning "slanderer" and aptly identifies the sinister character of Satan who is declared to be the accuser of the brethren. He is called the "Great Red Dragon," among other names. He is not God, but an angel. He has great power, but not all power. He is not omnipresent, nor is he omniscient. He is a liar from the beginning and all that he can do is lie; his power over you is in the lie. He is the prince of the power of the air who currently has access to the second heaven and all the earth. He is a devourer who roams about seeking his victims. He is transformed into an angel of light as fits his character of deception, and is not red with horns and a pitchfork. According to scripture we see that he has only personally possessed one person (Judas Iscariot) but that he will possess one more in the near future, the "man of sin." He is already a defeated foe at the hands of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and will eventually be cast into the lake of fire to be tormented for ever and ever for his sins.

G. Devils/Demons.

The word devil is also applied to the one-third of God's angels who rebelled with Lucifer, thus taking on his nature and character. They are also called in scripture, "unclean spirits," "evil spirits," and "his (the Devil) angels." They are able to oppress and possess people and can inhabit animals. Devils are indeed worshipped by people in the world today just as in times past. Sacrifices to devils has been common practice amongst devil а worshippers and is evidenced in scriptures. Not all devil worship is overt; most is actually covert, as in the worship of idols or gods. Devil worship has priests and other names for religious leaders. Devils can be cast out of someone and all whom Jesus Christ commanded to do so, did. Devils have their own doctrines, dogmas, and creeds. All of the fallen angels have their eternal doom already sealed, just like their infamous leader, Satan.

H. Captivity.

There are many ways in which people are made or held captive, or prisoners, regarding

spiritual warfare, including believers. Captivity is a state of being led away from what was previously and kept from that previous state. Jesus Christ came to set the captives free indeed. Satan desires only to enslave and keep people in sin's prison.

I. Strong Holds.

Although the original writings of the Apostle Paul, and English translations up to the King James Bible uses two distinct words when speaking of our next topic, we tend to gloss over that fact and create one word, strongholds. It is given every time in scripture as a hold that is strong. It is seen as a place of refuge or safety in many instances and is represented as a place of warfare or escape therefrom. In the spiritual realm, strong holds are that which our Lord wants to, and is mighty to pull down, so that we may be free indeed.

- 1. Strong = fortified
- 2. Holds = castle, fortress

J. Spiritual Warfare Counseling
